2019 SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

VINTAGE:

The 2019 growing season provided ample rain and moderate weather through the summer, which helped us achieve our sought-after Sonoma Coast style: elegant, bright acidity, red fruit and earthy notes. As our vineyards mature, we are able to single out the blocks that most exemplify the Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir. I am using more focused, precision farming to get the flavors we are aiming for from specific sites, year after year. — Winemaker Heidi von der Mehden



WINEMAKING:

- Harvest dates: 9/9/2019-9/24/2019
- Pinot Noir grapes were hand-picked at night and hand sorted in the field and at the winery
- 100% De-stemmed - whole berries to fermenter
- Cold soaked an average 5 days
- Aged 11 months - 53% new French oak
- Clones: UCD37, Pommard, Swan, Dijon 115, Dijon 777
- Bottled on: 8/10/2020
