2022 DACH VINEYARD ANDER JON VALLEY PINOT NOIR

VINTAGE:

The certified-organic Dach vineyard in Anderson Valley is a model of balance: Beneficial plants provide habitat for friendly insects; all-natural compost restores soil and enhances fruit quality; cover crops benefit vineyard health and feed local sheep;



and the vineyard is Fish Friendly Farming certified. That balance in the vineyard is also displayed in the wines. 2022 Dach features a bold nose of red fruit, forest floor, plum and blueberry. A rich, inviting entry is balanced by crisp acidity and rounded tannins. Hints of almond and autumnal spices enhance the finish. — Winemaker Heidi von der Mehden
